



California & Oklahoma Game Specific Training

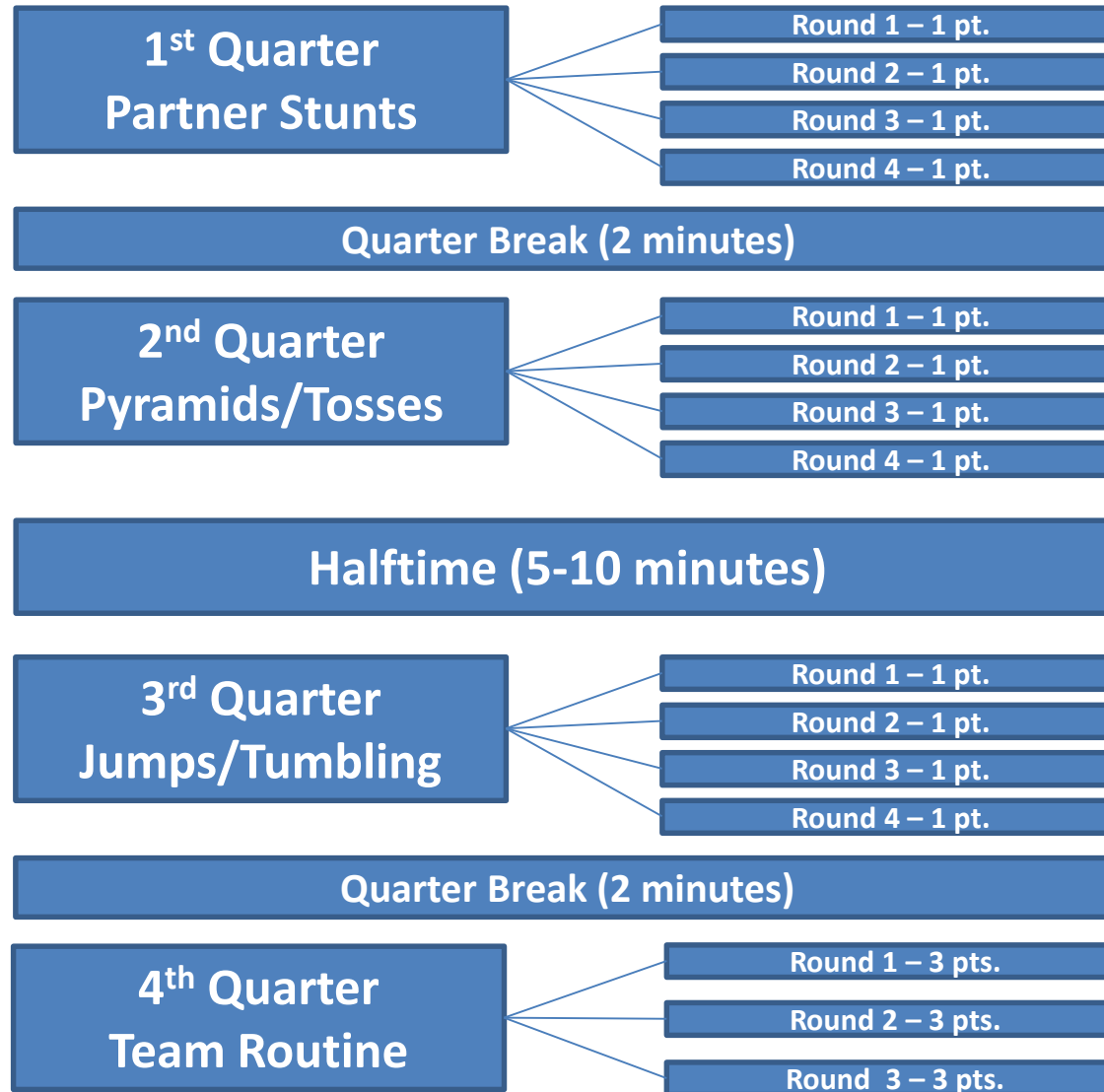

Makeup of a STUNT Team



- **Roster Specifics**
 - Minimum of 12 athletes required on a roster
 - There is no maximum number of athletes
- **Team Makeup**
 - Athletes must be official students enrolled at the school
 - Athletes are subject to their school's academic and athletic policies

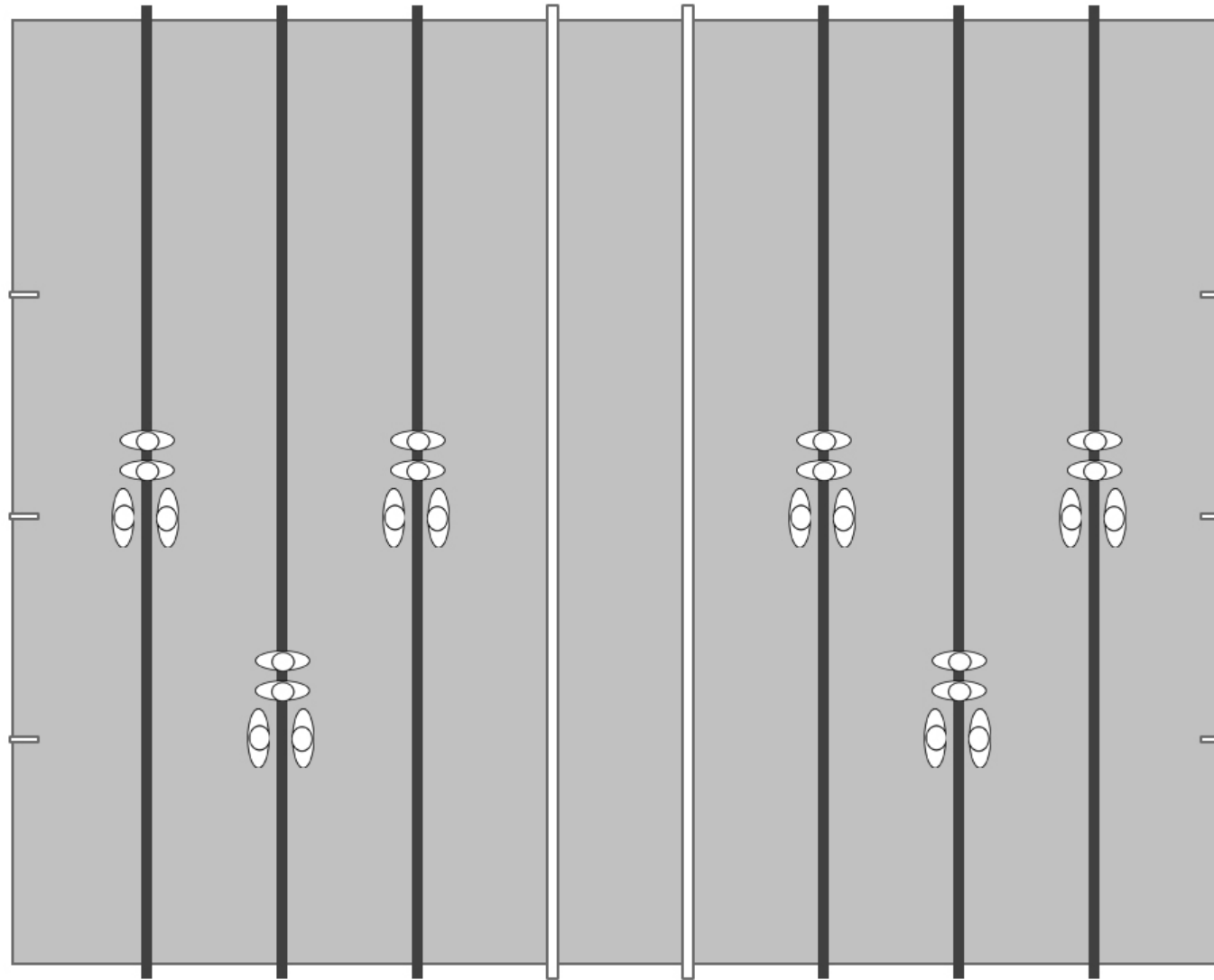
- **Routine Information**

- Partner Stunt Routine stunt groups:
 - Routines 1 & 2: 3 stunt groups
 - Routines 3 & 4: 2 stunt groups
 - Routines 5 & 6: 1 stunt group

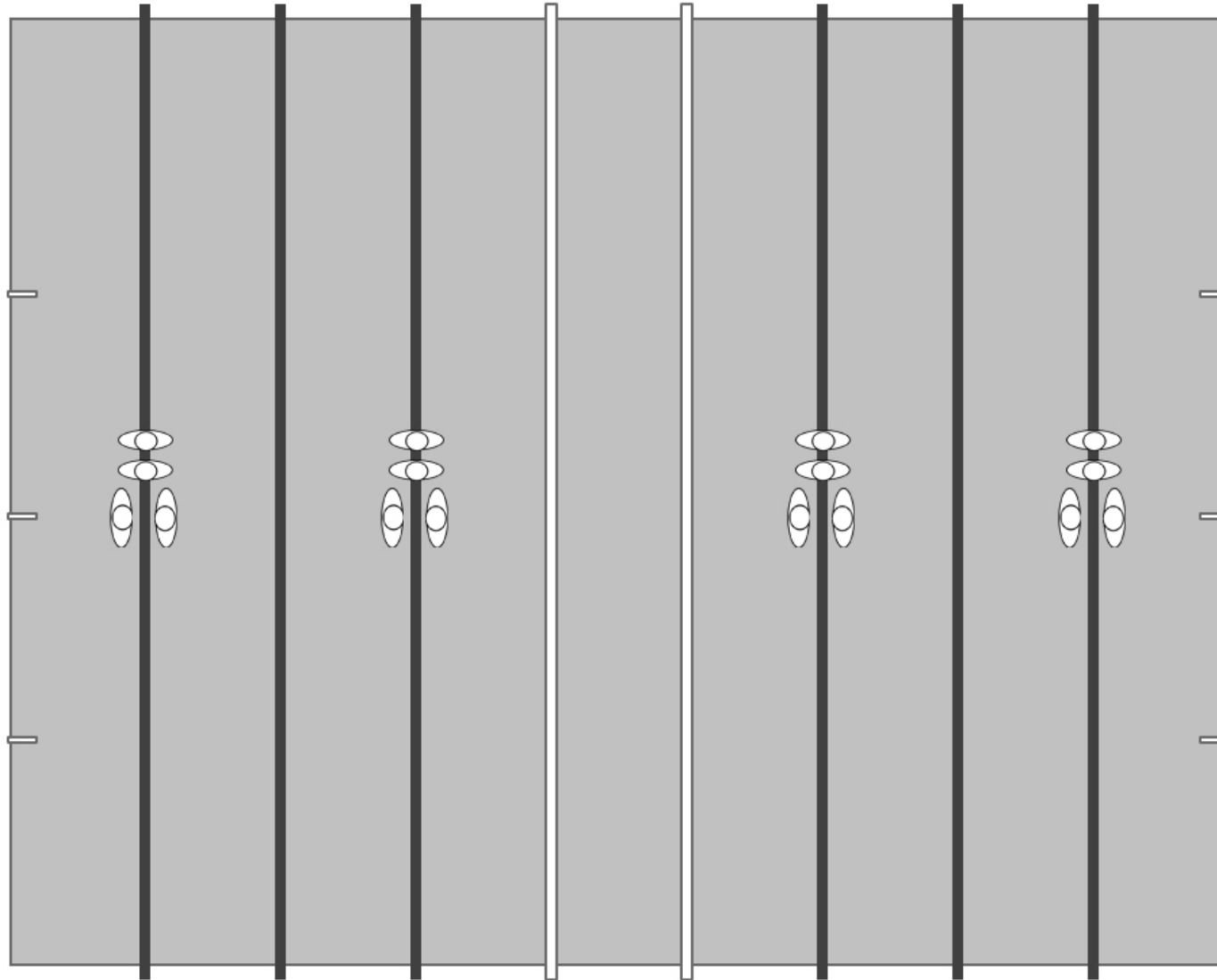

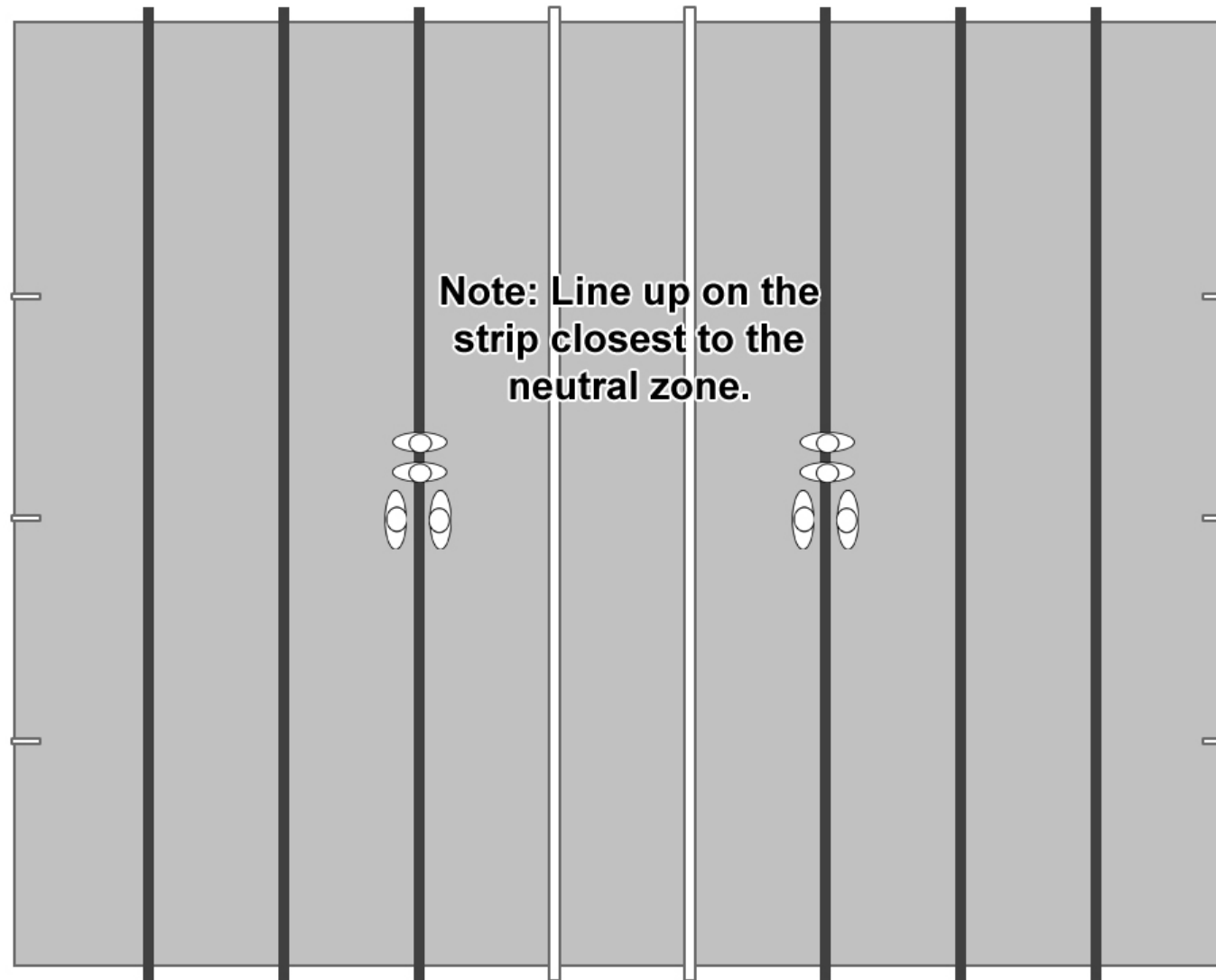
Formation for 3 Partner Stunt Groups
